

Western Dihedrals

Stone Free

9 Pitches, 5.12c

This climb follows the general line of the 1978 Cam Cairns & Darrel Hatton aid climb 'Getting Down on the Brown'.

Pitch 1

Climb the first pitch of Freeway

Pitch 2

Continue up the main corner.

Thin but good gear. 11b 15m

Pitch 3

Step Right, up a short left facing corner, arete, and right past a bolt leads to 'Sky Crag Ledge'

10a 17m

Pitch 4

'The Getting Down Corner'

Beautiful finger and hand crack endurance corner with a powerful stemming or bridging crux where the crack slams shut. 12a 35m

Pitch 5

'The Hidden Dihedral'

Hard and committing face moves to start followed by tips underclings, endurance laybacks and a bouldery but well protected crux.

Gear to #1 BD only. 12c 30m

Pitch 6

Up the corner and easier face above to Dihedral Ledge 5.9 20m

Pitch 7

Step right and up a steep and juggy pitch of crack and face to a nice ledge. 10b 30m

Pitch 8

Up the bolted chimney exiting left onto the arete at the 4th bolt.

10c 30m

Pitch 9

Step right, face climb past 2 bolts, traverse left and make athletic moves past 2 more bolts to a balancy finish. 11c 25m

Bolted for rappel. 5 raps down (25m, 60m, 55m, 57m, 60m to tree)

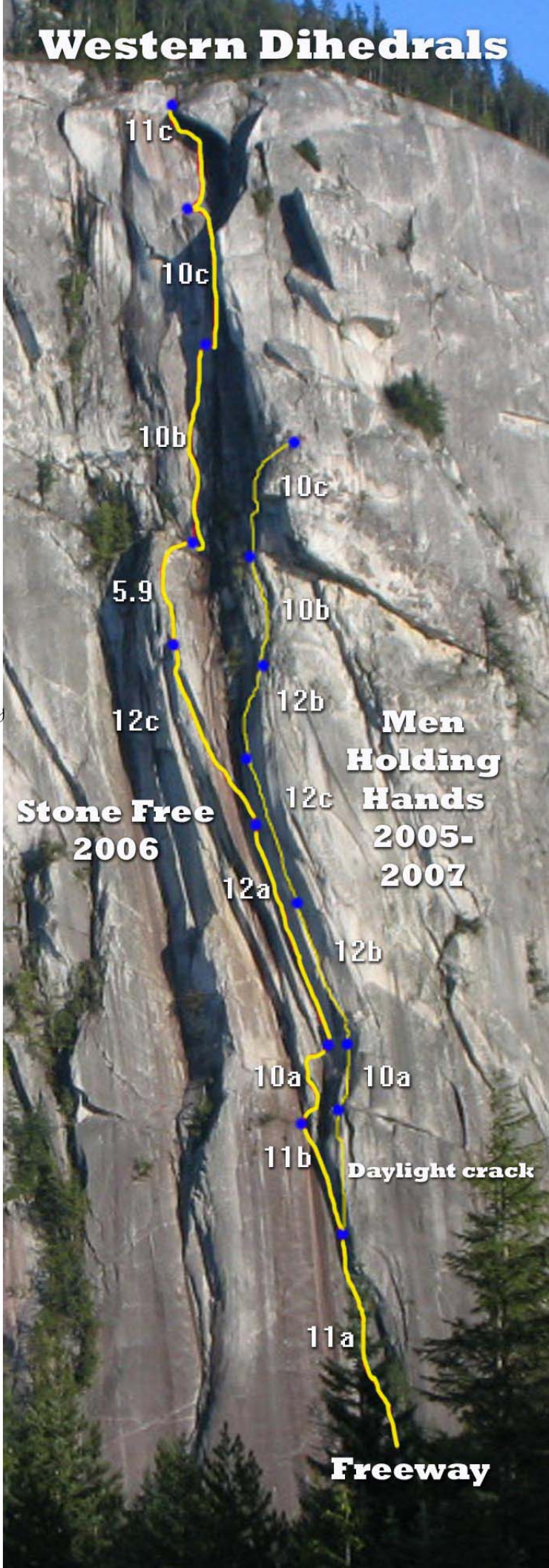
This climb was bolted on lead.

Gear:

- 1 set RP's
- 1 set Wires
- 1 set TCU's (00,0,1,2,3)
- 1 set Aliens (blue,green,yellow)
- 1 set cams BD .5 - #3
- 10 draws/runners

6 Pitch variation to Freeway

5.12c

This improbable line follows an exposed ramp and crackline up the golden overhanging wall left of 'Brothers in Arms'.

Pitch 1

Climb the first pitch of Freeway

Pitch 2

Climb 'Daylight Crack'

Pitch 3

After 'Daylight Crack' continue straight up to the 'Sky Crag'.

10a 17m

Link the first 3 pitches in 70m!

Pitch 4

This pitch has a prominent black streak that seeps until late summer.

Barn door moves past bolts to a thin tips layback crack. 12b 25m

Pitch 5

'The Thumb Ratchet Pitch'

Steep crack with big moves on good holds. Multiple cruxes.

Excellent climbing and position.

Gear to #1 BD only. 12c 25m

Pitch 6

'The Link Pitch'

A short and bouldery bit of Pet Wall style climbing. 12b 15m

Pitch 7

Follow the crack straight up to a left facing corner and ledge

10b 25m

Pitch 8

Pull the roof overhead on its right side to a ledge and up right on chicken heads past a bolt to

traverse into Freeway. 10c 30m

Finish up Freeway.

This climb was bolted on lead until pitch 5. Pitch 6 & 8 were bolted on rappel.

Gear:

- 1 set Wires
- 1 set TCU's (0,1,2,3)
- 1 set Aliens (blue, green, yellow)
- 1 set cams BD .5-#3
- 10 draws/runners
